To Delamp or not to Delamp?

- Permanent removal of at least one lamp from existing fixture
- Sockets and ballasts removed from fixture or reflector kit is installed
- Cannot remove more than 50% of existing lamp quantity (3 lamp to 1 lamp not allowed)
- Any ballast factor allowed
- Rebate for delamping only



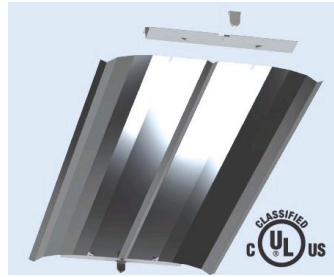

T8 to T8 Retrofit

- Permanent removal of at least one T8 lamp (delamp)
- Reflector kit allowed
- High efficiency electronic ballast
- Low or normal ballast factor for EnergySmart rebate
- Low ballast factor for Xcel rebate
- Any wattage of T8 allowed
- Platte River Power Authority custom rebate based on watts saved
